September 6-September 22, 2024

Sex, food, and money are high on the agenda in this adapted classic Italian comedy.
 Brighton, England. 1963. Change is in the air, and Francis Henshall is looking to make his mark. Fired from a skiffle band and in search of work, he finds himself employed by small-time gangster Roscoe Crabbe. But Roscoe is really Rachel, posing as her own dead brother, herself in love with Stanley Stubbers who, in turn, becomes our hero's other 'guvnor'. Fighting a mounting sense of confusion, Francis goes out of his way to serve both bosses. But with the distractions of a feminist book keeper, a self-important actor, and select members of the criminal fraternity (not to mention his own mammoth appetite) to contend with, how long can he keep them apart? Richard Bean's hilarious comedy received 5-star reviews from every London newspaper and was the hit of the 2012 Broadway season.

 MOUSETRAP**

October 18-November 3, 2024

The world's most successful and longest-running play comes to the TLT stage.
 After a murder, the guests and staff at Monkswell Manor find themselves stranded during a snowstorm. It soon becomes clear that the killer is among them, and the strangers grow increasingly suspicious of one another. A detective interrogates the suspects: the newlyweds running the house; a spinster with a curious background; an architect who seems better equipped to be a chef; a retired Army major; a strange man who claims his car has overturned in a drift; and a jurist who makes life miserable for everyone. When a second murder takes place, tensions and fears escalate. This record-breaking murder mystery features a brilliant surprise finish from Dame Agatha Christie, the foremost mystery writer of her time.

FIDDLER ON THE ROOF

December 6-December 29, 2024

The perfect mix of audience-pleasing humor and heart for the holidays.
 Set in the little village of Anatevka, the story centers on Tevye, a poor milkman, and his five daughters. With the help of a colorful and tight-knit Jewish community, Tevye tries to protect his daughters and instill them with traditional values in the face of changing social mores and the growing anti-Semitism of Czarist Russia. Rich in historical and ethnic detail, *Fiddler on the Roof's* universal theme of tradition cuts across barriers of race, class, nationality, and religion, leaving audiences crying tears of laughter, joy, and sadness.

**THE CURIOUS INCIDENT OF
 THE DOG IN THE NIGHT-TIME**

January 24-February 9, 2025

Dazzlingly inventive Olivier and Tony-Award-winning play about the wonders of life.
 15-year-old Christopher has an extraordinary brain: He is exceptional at mathematics but ill-equipped to interpret everyday life. He has never ventured alone beyond the end of his road, he detests being touched, and he distrusts strangers. Now it is seven minutes after midnight, and Christopher stands beside his neighbor's dead dog, Wellington, who has been speared with a garden fork. Finding himself under suspicion, Christopher is determined to solve the mystery of who murdered Wellington, and he carefully records each fact of the crime. But his detective work takes him on a thrilling journey that upturns his world.

**LORCA IN A
 GREEN DRESS**

March 7-March 23, 2025

TLT and UWT bring Pulitzer Prize-winner, Nilo Cruz's surrealist play to life.
Lorca in a Green Dress pays homage to Federico García Lorca, writer of *Gypsy Ballads*, *Mariana Pineda*, and *Play Without a Title*. Lorca was killed by fascist forces on August 19, 1936 in the opening days of the Spanish Civil War. Upon his death, the great Spanish poet arrives in the "Lorca Room" in purgatory where he learns he will be quarantined for the next 40 days. With dramatic and sensual flamenco flair, *Lorca in a Green Dress* is a spellbinding exploration of the life and death of Lorca. Five different actors portray aspects of the poet's personality in a surrealistic landscape that questions what it means to die, to live, to create and to love.

BUG

April 25-May 11, 2025

The line between reality and delusion is blurred in this thriller.
 The play centers on the meeting between Agnes, a lonely divorcee, and Peter, a soft-spoken Gulf War drifter. Agnes stays at a seedy motel in hopes of avoiding her abusive ex-husband, Jerry. At first, she lets Peter sleep platonically on her floor, but not long after he is promoted to the bed. Matters become more complicated as Jerry eagerly returns expecting to resume their relationship. On top of that, there's a hidden bug infestation that has both Agnes and Peter dealing with scathing welts and festering sores—which has Peter believing this is the result of experiments conducted on him during his stay at an Army hospital. Their fears soon escalate to paranoia, conspiracy theories and twisted psychological motives.

ROCKY

June 6-June 29, 2025

The greatest underdog story of our time, live onstage.
 Rocky Balboa is a small-time boxer who is chosen to take on the reigning world heavyweight champion, Apollo Creed, when the undefeated fighter's scheduled opponent is injured. While he diligently trains for the fight, Rocky begins a relationship with Adrian. As their love grows, they find their inner strength and bring out the best in each other. *Rocky* is a hard-hitting yet tender musical with music and lyrics by Tony winners and Academy Award nominees Lynn Ahrens and Stephen Flaherty, and a book by multiple Tony winner Thomas Meehan, adapted from the acclaimed Oscar-nominated screenplay by Sylvester Stallone.

SEASON TICKET

1. A Season Ticket is good for one seat to all SEVEN (7) of our regular season productions.
2. If necessary, you can exchange your Season Ticket by calling the Box Office at (253) 272-2281 at least 24 hours in advance.
3. 2024-2025 Season Tickets are only valid from September 6th, 2024 to June 29th, 2025.

FLEX PASS

1. Flex Passes can be redeemed for tickets by calling the Box Office at least 24 hours before the performance.
2. Flex Passes are only valid for regular season performances. They are not valid for SPECIAL EVENTS.
3. Flex Passes can be used however the patron prefers. There are SIX (6) punches available.
4. Once reservations are made with the Flex Pass, there are no refunds but we offer an exchange for no extra fee.
5. 2023-2024 Flex Passes are only valid from September 6th, 2024 to June 29th, 2025.
