



Curt was last seen as Rogers in RCTs production of And Then There Were None, as Gregor in VCPs production of Saving Grave and as General Custer in Nu Black Arts West's production of Deadwood Dick: Legend Of The West. He has worked as Stage Manager for RCT's The Rocky Horror Show and was SM and Lighting Designer for BCT's Jesus Christ Superstar, The Good Doctor, and Driving Miss Daisy. The Renton Parks The Music Man, and RCT's Godspell and The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee. Director's Note

Farce is an interesting genre. It is not comedy in the same way as a script relying on word play. It is comedy relying on situations that are exaggerated to an extreme. Some of the best, A Midsummer Night's Dream, Noises Off, Love Sex and the IRS, Lend Me A Tenor, and Moon Over Buffalo, have a great set up. The last two are written by the same author as The Fox on the Fairway, Ken Ludwig. Ludwig uses some great devices in this production. One of those is his creation of the "Curtain Call" or retelling of the entire show in approximately 90 seconds. He created this device for Lend Me A Tenor. He chose to finally use it again on this production. It will leave you, as well as the cast, breathless. It is a wonderful device to relive the last two hours of the performance.

We are attempting to stay as true to his vision as possible. One of the beauties of working in theatre is that you get to create something new within the framework of what the author envisioned. I believe we have done that in this, I believe, the best of Ludwig's plays. We have had a lot of fun creating this production. The cast and crew are wonderful. The design team is one of the best I have worked with. I really appreciate all the efforts of the cast, crew and designers in getting this production ready for your viewing.

I want to thank my wife, Stacy, for understanding about all the time away from home it takes to ready a production for an audience. I love you.

Laughter is really the best medicine. This will relieve you of whatever is bringing you down. Please sit back and enjoy this performance of *The Fox on the Fairway*.
