

director's note

David Lindsay-Abaire was known for his off-beat comedies until he was encouraged to write something different. Someone asked him: "What is it that scares you?" As a recent father, he knew the answer. In *Rabbit Hole*, a bittersweet and realistic story, we meet and get to know a family and a teenaged boy after a tragic accident. These funny, smart, opinionated, and passionate people seek comfort after a great loss. Their individual journeys through grief are full of many questions and a few unexpected connections.

I have admired this down-to-earth, complex, and delicate script for a long time, and was so pleased to be given the opportunity to direct it. It was truly wonderful to explore, collaborate, and work hard with these fine actors on this play, who wanted to be true to the humor and realism of this piece, as well as its heartbreak. We reveled in the unlikely intertwining of Alice in Wonderland, parallel universes, The Runaway Bunny, the Kennedy Curse, and Orpheus and Eurydice. And, with the help of the designers and production team, we did our best to bring this world fully to life for you.

As the playwright says----"Rabbit Hole is not a tidy play." Neither are our lives. Here's a look at our rough edges and the glimmer of hope that binds us together.


Jeffery Weaver (Resident Properties Manager)


