





Director's Note

Who doesn't LOVE Steve Martin ?!?! Those who grew up, as I did, watching him on *Saturday Night Live* remember him as the original "wild and crazy guy"- decked out in a white suit, playing the banjo alongside many comedy legends. As a child I knew him to be wildly funny but I had no knowledge of his talent as an author and a playwright.

While this is a wonderful, farcical, sociopolitical romp of a show focused on a pair of ladies underpants, it is so much more. Adapted from a 1910 German play by Carl Sternheim, it takes a glimpse at attitudes toward women at the turn of the century. Using comedic one-liners and jokes about underwear, the play is able to demonstrate what was, and often still is, viewed to be a woman's place in society. Through the use of the main male characters in this play we see the three only acceptable views on women at the time: 1) They should be subservient to men. 2) They are objects for sexual desire. 3) They must be protected.

Don't fret though. We also get to see the start of some push back from the ladies in this story - who I must admit are not innocent bystanders in the slightly naughty antics you're about to see.

I won't spoil it for you, I'll let you find out for yourself as you sit back and enjoy the show!! Be sure your underpants are on tight. We don't need any more scandals on our hands!!



Though he eventually abandoned comedy for a stream of hit movies as well as writing plays and novels, Martin remains one of the biggest and most important names in comedy of all time. He's a true comic genius.
