Director's Note

This show, as many know, holds a special place in my heart. Over a decade ago, my daughter played the role of the young kangaroo and I was asked to work backstage. It was the first official main stage production I was a part of and it was the first show I officially worked on with one of my theatre mentors, the late Marcus Walker. It was pure magic! Most theatre folks will know what I mean when I say it was "that show" for me. The one where the cast gels and you make life long friendships. Where every mention of it brings a smile to our face, over a decade later. I had reignited a lost love of theatre for me and like the Grinch, I'm sure my heart grew three sizes while working on it.

To say that I was thrilled to be offered the opportunity to direct *Seussical* as this season's holiday show would be an understatement. This show, with this amazing talented cast and crew, has been a dream come true. I do not have the words to express what it means to me to have had them, and now you, along on this journey. Sometimes, it's important to look back as we move forward. This project has allowed me to do just that and I am forever grateful.

Now you're asking, "What's so special about *Sensical*?" First, it's a mash-up of almost 20 of Dr Seuss' most loved stories. You really can't go wrong when you start there and *Sensical* does what any good musical does- it entertains! Most importantly however, hidden among all the clever rhymes and colorful characters, it accomplishes what all great theatre should- it makes us think! Great theatre can transport us to different worlds, worlds where magic is possible, and what a world Dr. Seuss has created! Deceptively simple, with fun rhymes and made up words, these stories, that we have loved since childhood, bring messages of tolerance, loyalty and friendship. In a world where people are often exposed to horrible realities, songs like "Alone in the Universe" and "Notice Me Horton" remind us to love the unseen. The lyrics of "Oh The Thinks You Can Think" remind us that it often takes big new ideas to change the world. "How Lucky You Are" puts personal challenges into perspective when compared to what's happening in the world around us.

Sit back, relax and allow your imagination to take you somewhere new. Let the world of Seuss wash away the stress of your busy lives.


Jeffery Weaver (Resident Properties Manager)




Jayda Slack (Blue Bird Girl)

Olivia Zamira (Who/Fish/Circus/Hunch)




