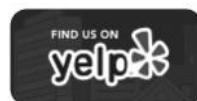
DIRECTOR'S NOTE

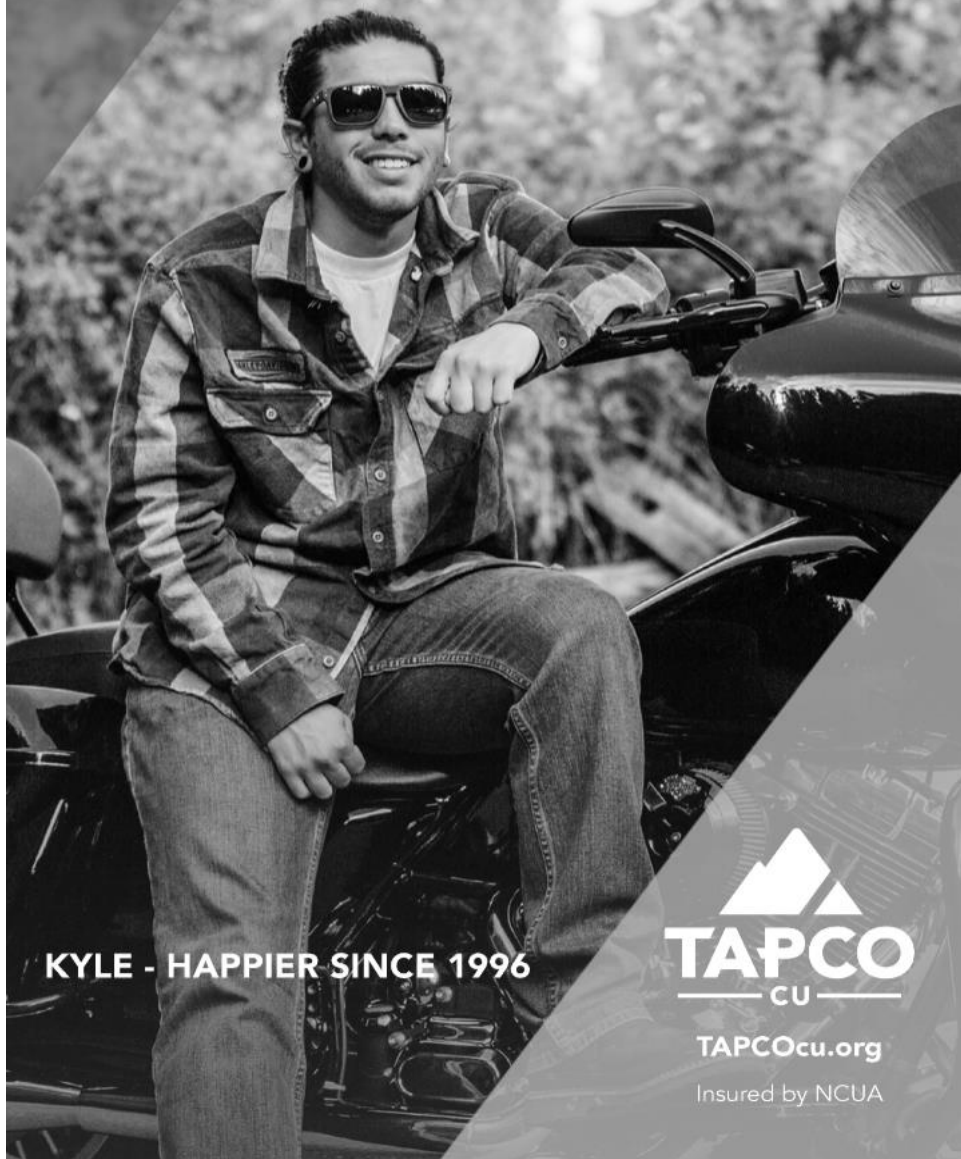
Jeffery Weaver (Resident Properties Manager/Wigs & Hair)
