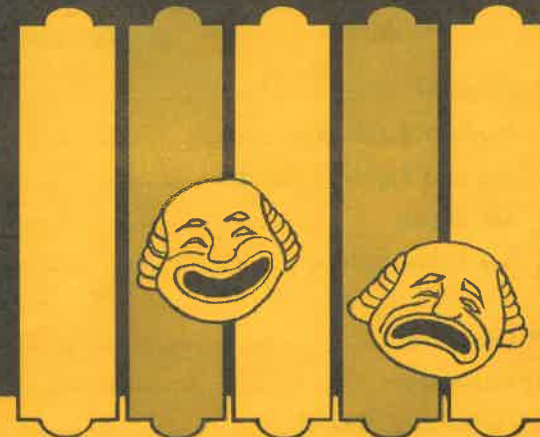

His interest in drama is not confined to acting as he has also written plays and stories. **Bev Pflugmacher** and **Dick Jones**, "Felicia" and "Fred", are both well known and much liked players at TLT. Both have a wide background in theater. **Bev** has appeared here in "The Mousetrap", "Night Watch" and many other roles which she has made into "special roles" with her talent. **Dick** has directed as well as acted in plays at TLT and other theaters.
