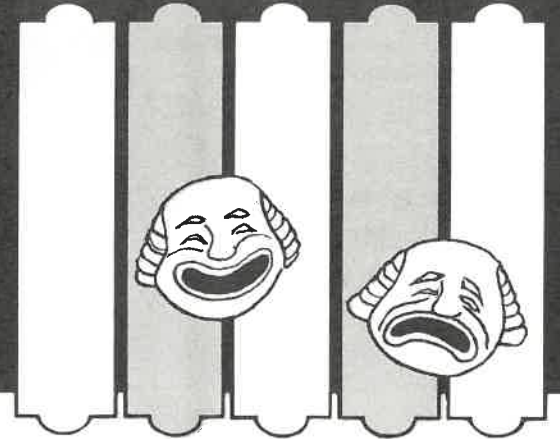

Andy's training at WWSC focused on technical theatre and directing. Another newcomer, **Dan Yeary**, from Modesto, California, performed in several musicals while studying drama at California State College. **Bill Cox** is a Southern Methodist University graduate and program director for our local television station. Bill is recreating the role he played two years ago with a Dallas theatre company. Tacoma Art Commission's executive Director, **Dick Trapp**, a past Dickie Award winner for "Anastasia" recently directed the Chinook Dinner Theatre production, "Owl and the Pussycat". A long time favorite of musical comedy audiences, **Sharry O'Hare** appears here as the tone deaf Vicar's wife who sings only "off key".

Bob Rodriguez directed "Cat on a Hot Tin Roof" for TLT last year and is presently teaching recreational drama at Fort Steilacoom College. Lakewood Player fans may remember **Trish Tuggle** as Miss Skillon in "Pool's Paradise, the sequel to "See How They Run". **Rolly Opsahl** played the cantankerous, chauvinist hero in last year's hit comedy "Life With Father." Director **Michael Self**, a newly elected TLT board member, is another musical comedy favorite. Michael directed and performed in the popular run of "I Do, I Do" at Fort Lewis.
