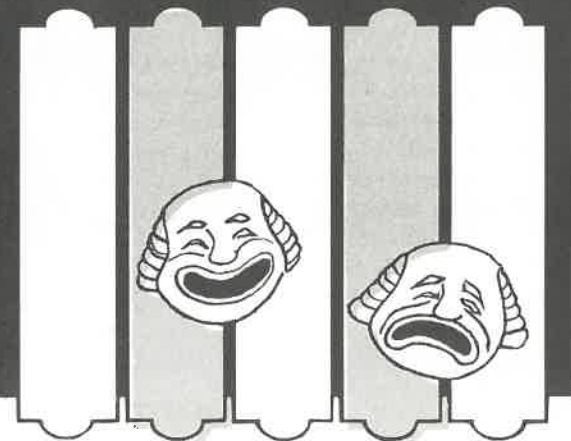
"Babes In Arms"
