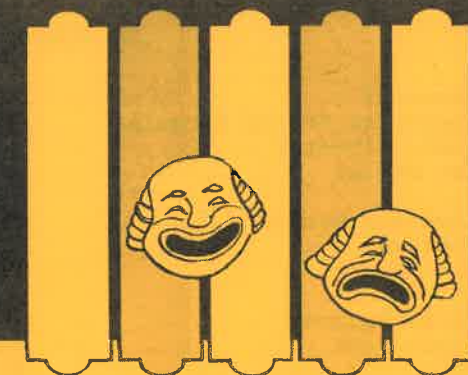
The annual dinner for the presentation of the "Dickie
