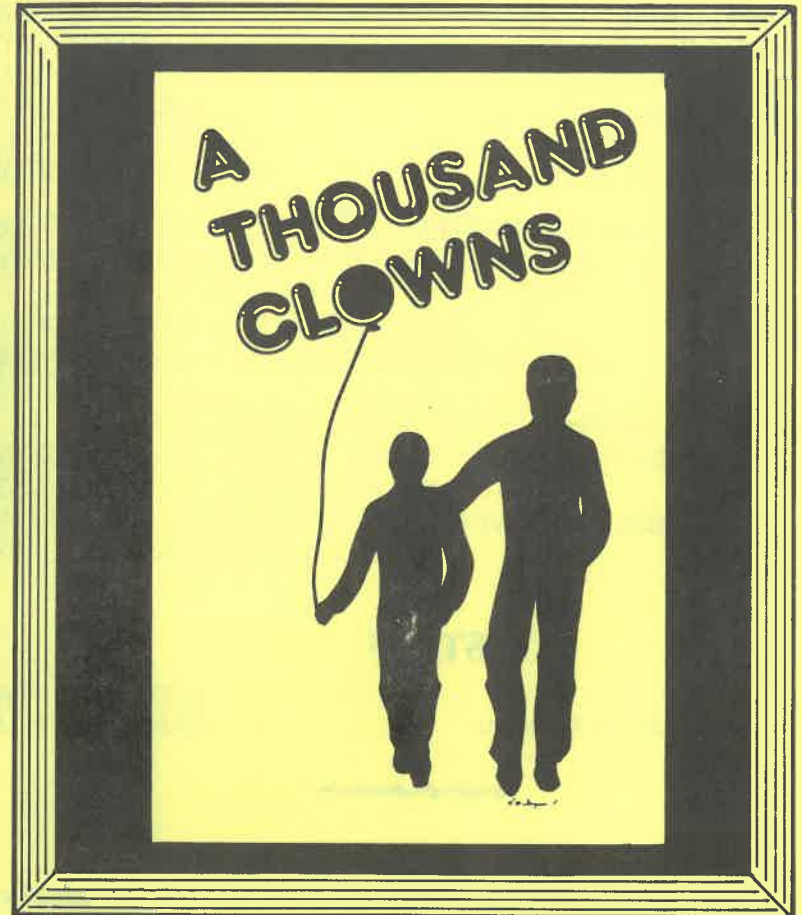

Scene 2: Arnold Burns' office, later that afternoon.


Scene 3: Murray Burns' apartment, early that evening.

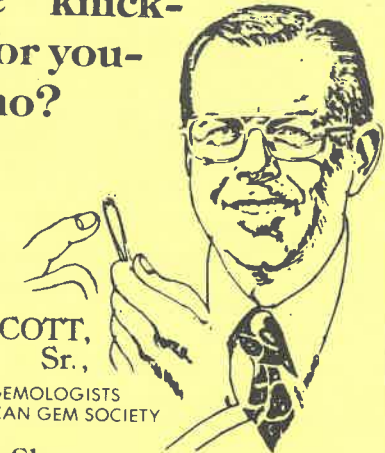

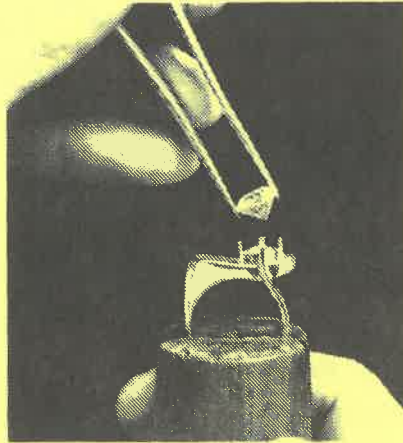
