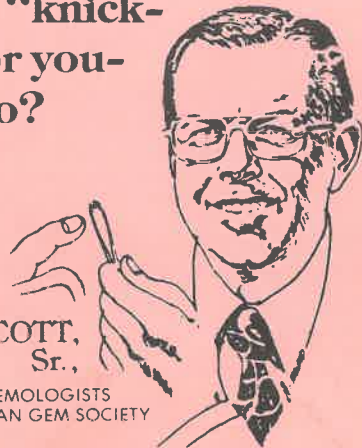

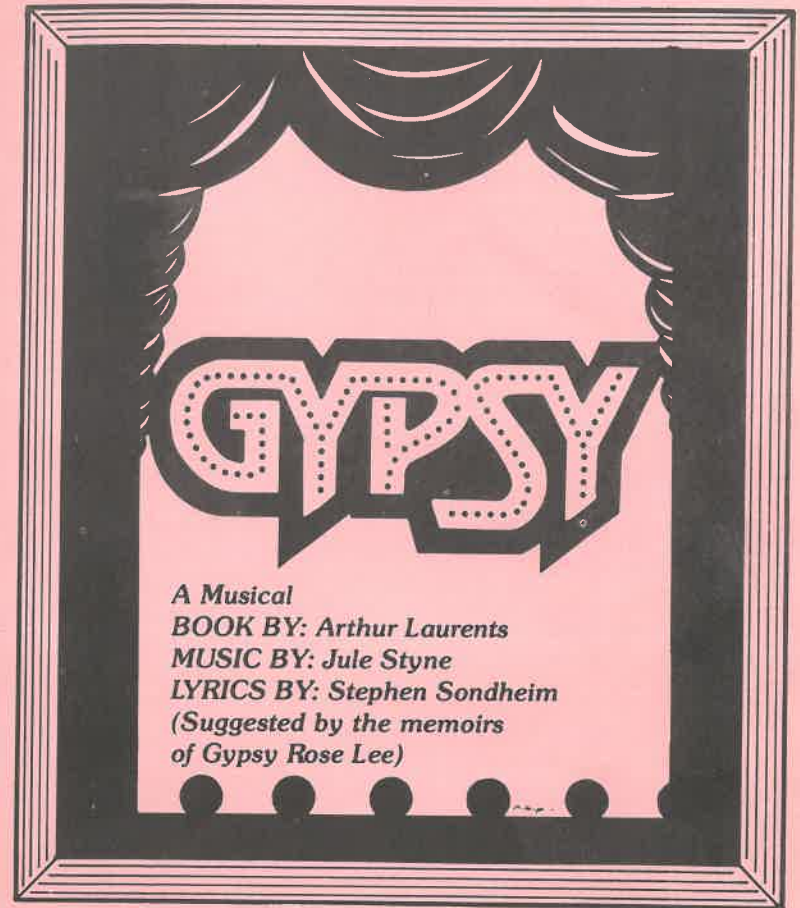



THIS MONTH IN THE STAGE DOOR GALLERY: PACIFIC GALLERY ARTISTS

During the run of "Gypsy," the work of members of Pacific Gallery Artists will grace our gallery. Organized in 1947, the group is made up largely of professional painters, sculptors and craftsmen. All of the members participate and win prizes often in many local art shows, including Women In Art, Lakewood Art Show, the Western Washington Fair, etc. . . . Annual events include the presentation of a scholarship to a talented college student and an open show in March. The organization is financed by an auction in November and a wine and cheese-tasting party. P.G.A.'s current president is Mary Seymour. This fine local group has had a show at TLT for many years now, usually in the same June time slot, and we are happy and proud to welcome them again! Please note that their work may be viewed during regular office hours (Tuesday Saturday 1 till 6 p.m.) as well as during performances. Most of the artwork is for sale; purchases may be made through the box office.

HISTORICAL NOTE

First copy righted in 1959, "Gypsy" was produced for the Broadway stage by David Merrick and Leland Hayward. Ethel Merman created the role of Rose in that production, with Jack Klugman as Herbie, Sandra Church as Louise and Lane Bradbury as June.

Of special interest to us locally is the fact that Gypsy's life and career began in Seattle. She was born and lived there off and on with her mother and sisters June in their grandfather's house. Their vaudeville act was first performed in local lodge halls there, then progressed to Seattle's vaudeville houses before moving on to other locales and better-paying, somewhat higher-quality theatres.
