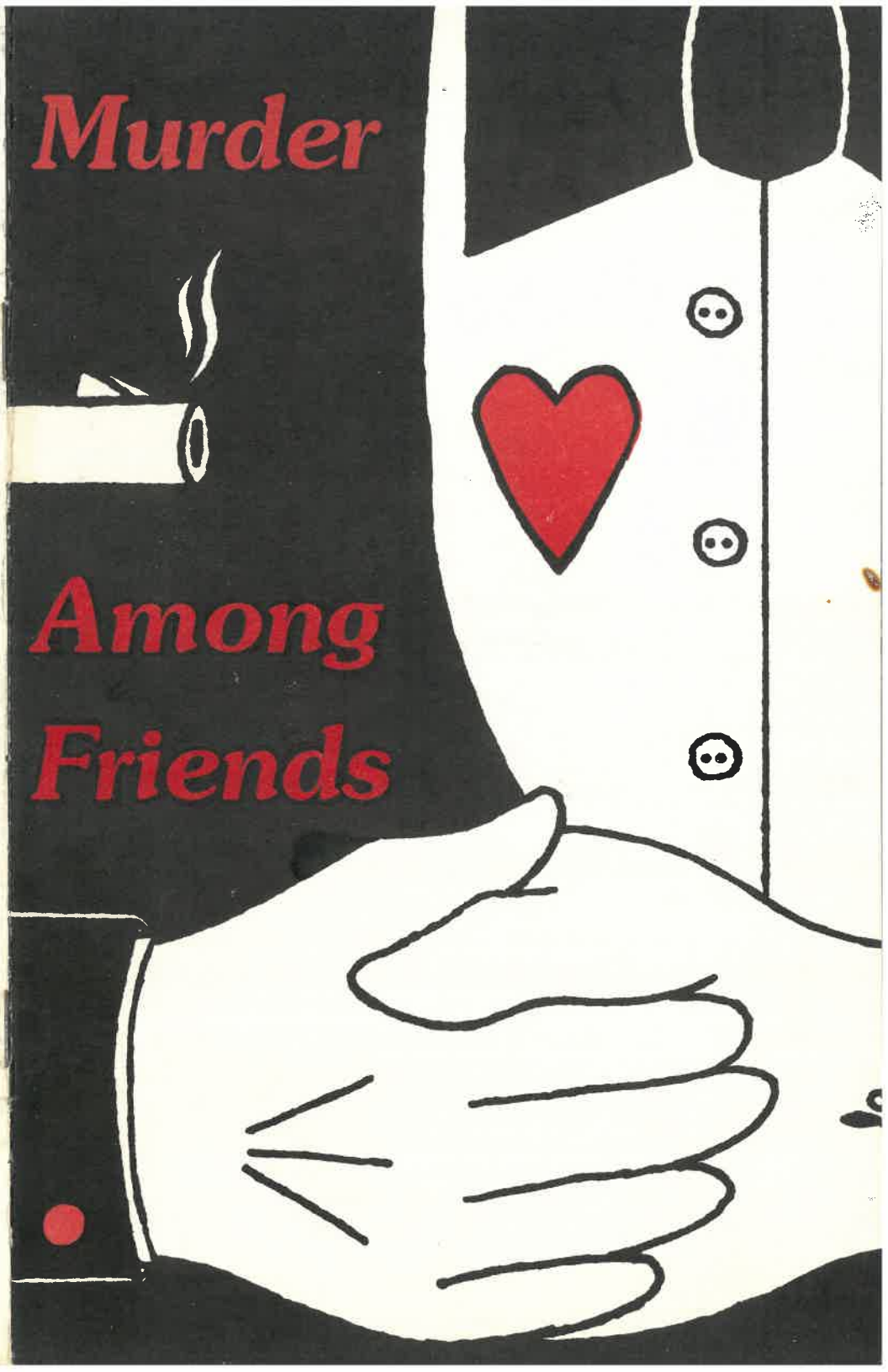

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST

He has done some radio and television work in his hometown, Versailles, Kentucky, and recently appeared in two locally filmed movies, *Frances* and *Divorce Wars*. Says Deward: "All you have to do to keep your head straight is listen to country-western music and read the verses on the Hallmark Cards."
