

About The Cast

Penny Culver (Bella). Penny is a very industrious lady who has 3 "theatre type" daughters, works as a volunteer trainer for the Girl Scouts and is the senior high youth club coordinator for The Little Church on The Prarie. She was a talk show host with KLAY Radio for six months and she manages to persue her theatre interest with professional dedication. You will remember Penny's performance at T.L.T. in ARMS AND THE MAN, LILY, THE FELON'S DAUGHTER and SOUTH PACIFIC. She is presently working on a one-woman show BELLE OF AMHERST, a benefit production at Sequim in January.

David A. Starkweather (Mr. Manningham). David was last seen as "Slim" in *OF MICE AND MEN*, at the now defunct Centerstage Theatre in Federal Way. Generally most of his acting has been out of Washington and in Nebraska, Colorado and Minnesota. David's favorite roles were "George" in *WHO'S AFRAID OF VIRGINIA WOOLF?*, "Biff", *DEATH OF A SALESMAN*, "Hal", *PICNIC*, "Phillip", *LION IN WINTER*, and "Eeyore" in *WINNIE THE POOH* (ha ha). His most recent endeavors have been directing projects which he produced at Tacoma Community College. Last summer Jean-Paul Sartres' *NO EXIT* and September the highly intense, *EXTREMITIES*. David's educational experience includes a (near) MA from The University of Minnesota in Directing and Theatre History, and a BA in Speech and Drama from Chadron State College in Nebraska.

Barbara Gauny (Nancy). Barbara's been involved with theatre in Tacoma for the past seven years. She appeared in five productions which were at Fort Lewis. Her favorites were ANNIE GET YOUR GUN, JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR and SCROOGE. Her T.L.T. credit was in January 1979 in the MIKADO. We are happy to have her return to T.L.T.

Shirley Coffin (Elizabeth). Though a first time performer with Tacoma Little Theatre, Shirley is a veteran member of The Performance Circle. She has been involved in every phase of theatre production: Directed, Costume Design, Box Office, Public Relations/-Publicity, Management as well as acting. She has yet to design a set but Shirley has pulled her share of nails and spread a little paint from time to time. Shirley's acting credits include Shakesperian, Classical, Contemporary and Musicals.
