Scene One: Home of Brian and Anne, early morning

Scene Two: Same, evening

Scene Three: Same, following morning

About the Cast:

John Miller (General Samuel Davis) is a retired Army officer who has lived in the Northwest since 1969. His theatre career began when he performed as part of the barbershop quartet in 'Music Man' in 1984. Since then he has acted in 'Amadeus,' '1776,' 'The Importance of Being Earnest,' 'Whodunnit?' and 'The Foreigner.' He was last seen at TLT in 'Oliver!'

Jerry Foster (Owen Corbett) returned to Tacoma from New York City five years ago and has pursued his acting and directing careers vigorously since then. He directed 'As Is' at Lakewood Players; appeared in 'Charley's Aunt' at Lakewood, 'The Odd Couple' at Performance Circle and 'Ring Round the Moon' at TLT.

Alan Marshall Brown (Dennis Harper) was just seen as The Reverend Lionel Toop in TLT's production of 'See How They Run' and appeared last season in 'Crimes of the Heart' here. He has acted in theatres in Portland, Salem, Denver and Tacoma and directed productions in Denver. He studied theatre at Willamette University.

Paul Van Aire (Lieutenant Arthur Jenkins) is a Seattle native making his debut on a Tacoma stage at TLT. He has acted in several productions since 1977, including 'Arsenic and Old Lace,' 'To Kill A Mockingbird,' 'Passport to Ballard,' and Tom Stoppard's 'The Real Thing' at Spokane Interplayers. His first film will be released before Thanksgiving. A former Marine, Paul draws on life experience for 'Semper Fi.'

Tim Hoban (Brian Corbett) is a Tacoma native who first appeared at TLT in 1984. He has performed locally at Lakewood Players, Performance Circle, and spent five months as an understudy in 'The Nerd' at Pioneer Square Theatre. He also appears Saturday nights at 11 p.m. on 'The Spud Goodman Show' live on TCI cable channel 35.

Elisa Sullivan (Anne Corbett) just graduated from Pacific Lutheran University with a bachelor's degree in philosophy. She appeared in 'Agnes of God,' 'The Lark,' and other productions at PLU. She is making her debut at TLT.

Sandra L. Dillin (Agnes Corbett) last appeared at TLT in 'Gypsy.' Her most recent stage performance was 'A Little Night Music' at Performance Circle. She has also appeared in 'Guys and Dolls' for Tacoma Actors Guild, 'Element of Doubt' and 'Promenade' at the University of Puget Sound, as well as 'Alice in Wonderland or What's A Nice Girl Like You Doing in a Place Like This?' for Metropolitan Park District. She is an accomplished pianist as well as singer.

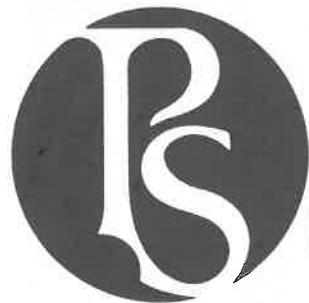

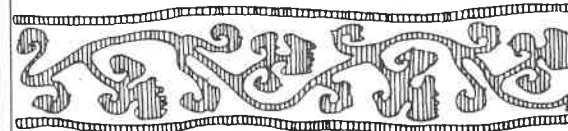

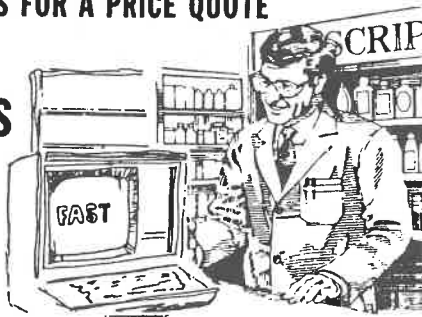
