

Director's Notes

King Arthur: A new order, a new order, where might is used only for right, to build instead of destroy.

Camelot was first produced in 1960, a time of boundless optimism (which many would call naivete). I grew up in a subsequent, more cynical age, and to hear polititians bandying about vacant promises of a "new world order" generally leaves me cold. And yet I find Camelot deeply inspiring. For in the world of Camelot, ideals are genuine and heart-felt. Armed with ideals, fortified with resolve. Arthur succeeds in building a great civilization. Human imperfections ultimately cause the system to founder, but Arthur's ideals live on in the dreams of the next generation. In these troubled, apathetic times, Camelot offers hope that ideals can indeed rejuvenate a society and drive it toward a better future.

King Arthur, Mark Anthony Flora - Last summer Mark played Motel in Fiddler on the Roof at NSCT. In Seattle he appeared in Candide at the Evergreen theatre Company. He toured with The AIDS Show and performed in Boy's Breath/Modern Men with the SF International Theatre Festival.






