Director's Notes

A society that defines its members as winners or losers, have and have nots, has no room for fools who would have us "lose our life to find it."

We are wayward saints all, with our heads in heaven and our feet in clay. We hope that tonight you too, join with our company; and help us remember what life is for, as we love, learn, work, and "clown around" together on this beautiful and sacred planet we call home.

He also studied with Bonnie Hoffman at Bellevue Community

College and performed as Michael in Key Exchange and Ray in Lone Star. Michael would especially like to thank his wife, Dolores and their three young children. Their encouragement, patience, and love are what made his participation possible, and his performances are affectionately dedicated to them.

Columbine, Frances Hearn - Frances graduated from the Evergreen State College in 1988, the same year she took her first acting class. Now, four years later, she performs with Playback Theatre Northwest, an improvisational drama group based in Seattle. A Company of Wayward Saints at TLT is Frances' first scripted performance.

Ruffiana, Carol Eileen Mazer - TLT Audiences may remember Carol as Kate in Brighton Beach Memoirs. Since then she sang the Cameo Role of Bertha in Lakewoods production of Pippin. In 86/87 Carol toured the US & Canada with the Missoula Children's Theatre Production of Cinderella, having done Snow White the previous summer. She played Bloody Mary in Carrousell Players South Pacific and just finished her victory role as the Mouse King in BalleTacoma's Nutcracker. At present she is the acting coach for BalleTacoma. Trained at WWU, Cornish, and HB Studio NY, Carol is pursuing a career in Theatre, Film & AstralProjection.

Capitano, Terry Parker - Terry Parker is a teacher at Gig Harbor High School. His past credits include work with the Old Bellevue Playbarn, Spokane Civic Theatre, and Summer Stock at the Coaster Theatre in Cannon Beach, Oregon. Most recently he played Joe Keller at TLT last season in a production of Arthur Miller's All My Sons. He has two grown boys who are also pursuing the arts, one in film and the other in theatre. Pantalone, Gary Pinkney - Gary comes to Tacoma little Theatre by way of Brooklyn, NY. A Tacoma resident for the past 12

years, he is the producer/director of ABLE Videos, Video Co. Last fall he played three roles in the TLT production of The Wiz. He is a family man, and his three talented daughters are also interested in the arts. Acting is fun and it helps him to relax.

Agatha, Amber D Salcido - Amber, at the age of five started performing for her hometown church, Grace Brethren and then began singing for her school performances. She has performed in The Wizard of Oz, Pinochio, and the Stories of Hans Christian Anderson for Missoula Childrens' Theatre. Currently, she has been singing with her high school concert choir, and auditioning for the Performance Circle and TLT where she has been rewarded with roles including one in A Company of Wayward Saints.

Scapino, David Sullivan - David has been absent from community theater for the last 18 years: he's spent that time growing up, scraping knees, avoiding school, and perpetually cleaning his bedroom.
