Allusions To Myth & Reality

In 1978 a Gallup Poll showed that more than half of all Americans believed in angels.

We felt guided by the flutter of angel wings on our respective brushes, lens, and saws to show our work together: this seems an inspired, although logical, elaboration of our individual work imaging the messengers and guardians from the spirit world. Depicting the lighter than air qualities of these beings and their sometimes amusing historical representation is one of the joys of such "inspiration". By suspending the laws of gravity and utilizing the mythic airspace we hope to create an environment that instills within each viewer the wonder, awe and sense of discovery that exemplify the fragility of the human spirit.

The term 'angel' stems from the early Greek word 'angelos' which literally means messenger and was later adopted in the ecclesiastical Greek to mean 'messenger of god'.

The concept of the angel, historically, encompasses a vast range of immortal personifications. These beings are generally accepted in recent mythological and religious belief as intermediaries between a

deity and the mortal human.
Outside of the Christian tradition many cultures have also created angel-like beings personifying a spectrum of powers as guardians and messengers. One example is the Hindu <u>aparas</u> who were the dispensers of sensual bliss to the blessed ones.






