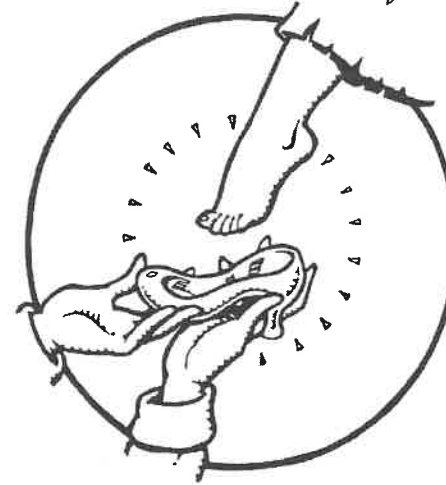

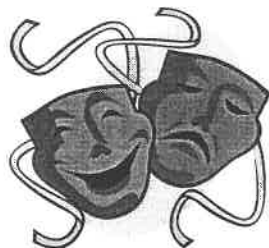

### Cynthia Wheaton, Costume Design Coordinator

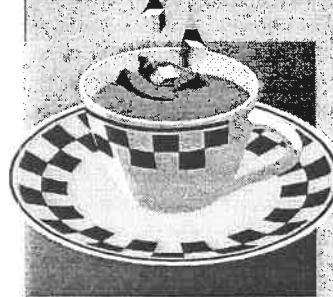
