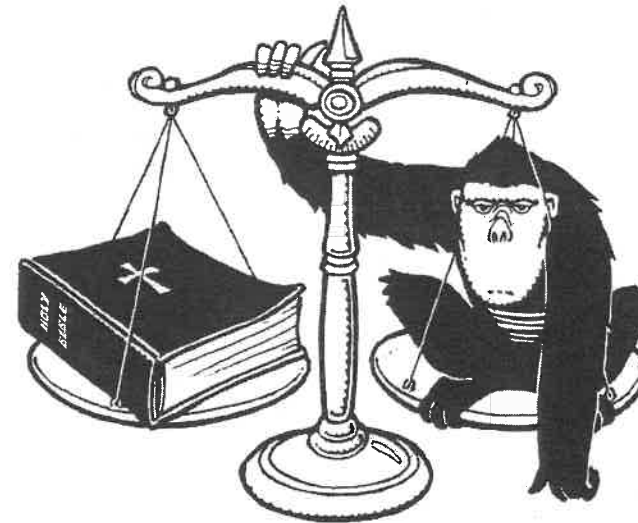

## Endowments

Endowments achieve donors' objectives in perpetuity and can be created through current or testamentary gifts of cash, securities or other appreciated property. Contact the CCA/ArtsFund office to explore creating a permanent fund to sustain area arts groups.

### D.E. "Ned" Skinner Endowment Fund

Established in 1988 in memory of the noted civic leader and arts patron Ned Skinner. Through 2001, CCA has made over \$871,500 in grants to small and midsize arts groups from this \$2.1 million fund.

### The Ackerley Excellence Fund

In 1997, Barry & Ginger Ackerley established this fund with a personal gift of \$1 million. Earnings from the fund reward excellence among CCA beneficiaries, most recently to Seattle Opera, Seattle Symphony and Seattle Repertory Theatre.

### The Kreihsheimer Fund

Established in 2000, by a \$1 million endowment gift from the Kreihsheimer Foundation, the Kreihsheimer Fund will provide grants in support of CCA/ArtsFund sustaining beneficiaries. The first grants from fund earnings were made in 2001.

### Classical KING-FM 98.1

In 1994, Priscilla Bullitt Collins and Harriet Stimson Bullitt gave CCA one-third ownership of Classical KING-FM 98.1. CCA distributes its share of dividends to music groups, totaling over \$1,000,000 to date.

### Guendolen Carkeek Plestcheeff Decorative and Design Arts Fund

In 1996, Corporate Council received more than \$600,000 from the estate of Guendolen Carkeek Plestcheeff. Corporate Council makes grants from this fund for programming in the design and decorative arts.

### Stabilization Fund

Corporate Council received surplus funds from Seattle's National Arts Stabilization program to provide stabilization-related technical assistance to arts groups.

### Jean T. Fukuda Memorial Fund

The Fukuda family and the Emeritus Corporation established this fund in memory of Ms. Fukuda's love of the performing arts. Earnings support CCA's performing arts beneficiaries.



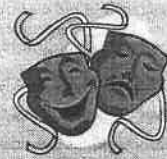
# Kids theatre-arts Programs for Spring!

## Photographer Clark Maffitt

If our artist's name and face look familiar, peek at our cast list again - he is also the wonderfully talented actor playing Henry Drummond in this production of *Inherit the Wind*!



Actor, musician, counselor, photographer, genealogy buff (and direct descendant of the likes of Charlemagne and Old King Cole!) Clark has been at home on stage since the 60s when he made his living as a musician, touring with the likes of Glenn Yarborough and the Everly Brothers. Long a favorite TLT performer, we are delighted to share another facet of the multi-talented Clark Maffitt with TLT audiences - that of photographic artist.

Clark's photography career boasts the same longevity as his performing career. "The first picture I ever developed was in my basement in 1963. When I saw that image come up in the tray, I felt this was *really cool!*" said Maffitt. Primarily an entertainment photographer for many years, Clark's photos have graced some 20 album covers for recording artists in a range of genres including folk, rock and country. Clark's expertise at portraiture has made him the first-call photographer for local actors and musicians seeking publicity shots. For the last couple of seasons, TLT has been lucky enough to have Clark take the cast photographs that grace TLT's foyer wall for every production.

Many things have changed since 1963. Well, for one thing, Clark's camera is now a state-of-the-art digital Minolta Dimage 7-1. But the art of capturing forms and shapes, and of revealing lives within faces, remains the artistic lure for Clark - and the reward for those of us who get to enjoy his beautiful work.
