Blake R. York (Director/Technical Director/Scenic Designer/Visuals)

Blake has been involved with theatre in the greater Puget Sound area for the past 17 years in a variety of roles. In that time he has worked on over 200 productions, from actor to stage manager, scenic designer to director and everything in between. Blake serves as TLT's Technical Director and Resident Scenic Designer. Previous directing credits include: *The Pillonman* (TLT), *Wedding Singer* (Broadway Olympia Productions), and *Terms of Endearment* (TLT). In 2019 Blake was named Best Director for the TLT production of *The Pillonman* at the AACT Regional Festival and won Best Scenic Designer in the AACT National Competition. In 2022, Blake was recognized as one of the 40 Under 40 by South Sound Business. Blake would like to send a huge thank you to the incredibly talented cast and production team for their hard work and dedication to bring this show to life. He would like to thank his wife Jen, his parents, and friends for everything they have done and continue to do for him.

J Wheeler (Stage Manager)

J has been in front of and behind the curtain in the Tacoma area for many years. You may have seen them acting as Alice Wendlekin in *The Best Christmas Pageant Ever* (LPH), or working as ASM on *Broadway Bound* (LPH), *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels* (Centerstage), and *A Christmas Story* (TLT). 


