Director's Note

When the idea of remounting *Steel Magnolias* came up, I found myself inspired by a decidedly feminine story that is both specific to time and place, but also universal in its themes and relationships. Our version stays true to the 1980's era, keeping Shelby on the cusp of fashion - and her mother, M'Lynn, stuck in the trends of her youth. It holds on to the Southern humor of smiley sarcasm and passive-aggressive quips. Most importantly, it honors the friendships developed by a group of women - women who endure the trials of life by relying on one another, providing each other strength in turn.

To truly reflect the American South, I was particularly interested in leaning into age, race, and socio-economics as lenses for the story. Why do women who are older, middle-aged, and young all go to the same salon? How do Black, white, and mixed-ethnicity women interact at a Black home salon? How does old money, new money, and poverty influence the women as they react to life?

On a personal note, I played Shelby at a small California theater only a few years after our setting of 1987. The Director, Barry Wallace, validated that a life in theatre was for me. It's a formative play for me. And, only a few years after that, I was diagnosed with a chronic kidney condition with lots of questions about the possibility of children. Thanks to UW Medical, I have three children and no more parallels to Shelby's life. THANK YOU to my children and husband for their continued support.

I'm so grateful for the opportunity to tell this beloved story with my own ethos of diversity. THANK YOU to Alyshia Collins, the designers, cast, crew, and support staff at TLT for their work and creativity in this show.

Staff Biographies Deanna Martinez (Director)

Deanna (she/her) has been a Director, Actor, and Coach at theaters throughout the Sound, and is the Associate Director of Arts Engagement at Seattle Rep. Her theatre students have been seen at Village, 5th Ave, SCT, Seattle Opera, and at community theaters throughout the region, as well as in commercials and film. With The Rep, she recruited, coached, and chaperoned students for the Next Narrative Monologue Competition, including the two regional finalists who performed at the Apollo in NYC. She also directed the new work, Cell Phone Unlocked, and coordinated the inaugural Youth Works Festival. Other recent directing credits include A 1940's Christmas Carol (Centerstage) and Polkadots: A Cool Kids Musical (TMP). She currently serves on the EDI committees for Tacoma Musical Playhouse and Centerstage (Federal Way), advocating for equity, diversity, and inclusion onstage, backstage, and in audiences.

Alyshia Collins (Stage Manager)

Alyshia has proven again that TLT can't get rid of her. Having started on this stage 21 years ago, she's thrilled to be lurking in the shadows again. Most recently, she stage managed *The Foreigner* (TLT) and *The Glass Menagerie* (Lakewood Playhouse). She also has assisted the after school camps here at TLT. Blake R. York (Technical Director/Scenic Designer/Visuals)


Aliyah Shines (Shelby Eatenton-Latcherie)




Janice Williams (Truvy Jones)
