After being away from the theater for so long, I am excited to "come home" and embrace the magic of this revolutionary art form that changes the world one stage at a time.

So welcome back home to the theater – there's really no place like home to truly enjoy the magic of this holiday season. Enjoy the show!


Erik Davis (Munchkin/Crow/Ozian/Winkie)


