DIRECTOR'S NOTE

"You'll shoot your eye out !!" and Santa's sardonic "Ho Ho Ho" as he crushes Ralpie's dreams are phrases that pepper the holiday season for my family year after year. Ralphie Parker and his quest for a Red Ryder 200-shot carbine action range model air rifle, with a compass and this thing that tells time built right into the stock, were a big part of the holidays for me growing up in the mid-west. We came to feel like we knew these characters personally – because we did. They are everyday people, living an ordinary life. They just happen to exist in 1940 but we know them well; a pesky little brother, childhood best friends, that first school crush, neighborhood bullies, disgruntled holiday elves... the list goes on. And who can't relate to the single-minded, tunnel vision approach, one gets in the pursuit of that one perfect gift? To this day I can't try on a jacket without throwing my arms straight out and whining "I can't put my arms down!!"

The 1983 film, on which this play is based, has become a holiday classic for families everywhere. Jean Shepherd's original short stories celebrated the rituals of American life. This story is less about the holiday itself and more about the feelings and moments that happen along the way. These moments resonate with us and, through stories like this, we relive them over and over again.

I had the privilege of recreating these moments for TLT several years ago and am honored to bring them to audiences again this holiday season. With this cast of actors, both new and well seasoned, we hope to recapture your childhood and take you back to the moments you cherished as a child watching this story for the first time. So get comfortable, leave the stress of a busy holiday season at the door and reminisce with a grown-up Ralph Parker about holidays long past.
